

Design a jersey competition

What is the competition:

- Hockey Ireland are running a design a jersey competition for clubs and players in the run up to the Tokyo Olympic Games 2021.
- Clubs are invited to take part by making the Design a Jersey Template available to all their primary school aged players.
- There will be two separate competitions:
 - 1st – 3rd class
 - 4th – 6th class

The winner of each competition will receive a Hockey Ireland Jersey replica jersey signed by the Women's International Team.

How does the competition work:

- Clubs who get involved in the competition are asked to make the template Design a Jersey pdf file available to their primary school aged members
- The club holds an in-club competition to select a winning jersey design at each or either age group to be sent into Hockey Ireland for the National competition
- Clubs are recommended to make use of their social media accounts for the in-club competition – online voting / Instagram polls / promotion of all entries on club website or social media to get young player involved
- Once the club has selected a winner for each or either age group these winning entries are to be sent onto Hockey Ireland Olympic.legacy@hockey.ie before the closing date of 14th July 2021
- The Hockey Ireland Youth Panel will be select a national winner at each age group and publicise the winning Jersey designs on Hockey Ireland Social Media the week before the Olympics begins.
- The winners will be contacted and receive a replica jersey signed by the Womens International Team

How else can your club get involved:

- Get your club to produce a Good Luck Green Army video
- Hold a colouring competition with your younger members using the Hockey Ireland Colouring Book
- Get all your players involved in completing the 21 Day Olympic challenge
- Host a mini Olympics competition
- Make the most of the Olympic Legacy and get your club involved with some of the Hockey Ireland Development Programmes
